Parent Support Advisor Update!

Please could we ask that all sickness and absence is reported to school via our absence line (01208 73218 option (1). If your child is absent due to illness please could you let us know what symptoms your child has - we request that you do not say just unwell.

If your child is absent due to illness for longer than 3 days we may request medical evidence such as a copy of a GP appointment or prescription in order to continue to authorise the absence. This is in line with our attendance policy which can be found on our website.
