End of Autumn term update

Dear Parents and Carers,

What a busy end of the term it has been; we have completed many Nativities, sang hymns and songs; created costumes; painted backdrops, decorated trees, planned parties and ate a Christmas Dinner; attended Christmas Fair's! It has been amazing and the children have all risen to the challenge and done their very best. Our children are so lovely, all of the teachers are so very proud of them all.

We return to school on the 4<sup>th</sup> of January for a couple of days. This is followed by a training day on the 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024. There is a further date for the two-day training on the 19<sup>th</sup> of February.

The training days are for Read, Write, Inc and it is part of our whole school focus on the teaching of phonics and developing early reading. There may be a few changes to come but we hope to update you with them as and when. We will also send out a help booklet to parents along with clips on ways to teach the sounds with the children, blend and how-to Fred talk!

At St Mary's, we have always gone over and above for all children in our care, particularly those with additional needs. This has been recognised by the SEN service team at County and because of this we are always recommended by professionals within education. As our school also has a large group of pupils who need pastoral care we are also being recommended as a school of choice for pupils who are within the care system.

This is partly due to the large pastoral team supporting pupils, but it is also down to our children and our parents who show love, care and support for all children we have in our care. St Mary's is a truly special school for that reason.

As SEND provision changes over time and practice continues to evolve, St Mary's too must move with the times and therefore our improvement focus revolves on the adaptation of the curriculum that enables pupils to achieve their very best irrespective of their need or ability. The new Plymouth CAST Special Educational Needs Pathways document clearly shows the work that we do and how we can support all of our pupils irrespective of their need.
