For period 17th Jan—5th Feb

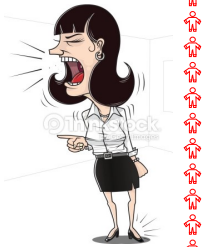
**Whole School Attendance: 93.5%**
